Matching number barrel. Metalwork has traces of blue and original grey patina with matching numbered bolt. GC correct original woodwork with armourers repairs and disc filled, Ski troop reversible side mounted sling assembly. Complete with correct sling and rod. GWO&C ALR

15 - ARISAKA TYPE I RIFLE

Rare and unusual Japanese Naval issue, circa 1938-1939 bolt action rifle. These rifles were produced in Italy for the Imperial Navy and is a hybrid of the type 38 and Carcano rifles. 31" 6.5 cal barrel with original sights, the chamber marked correctly with only the H prefix number. The action has correct 'Carcano' type bolt with proof marks. Metalwork has all over bright blue to the barrel and action with some speckling and minor loss to the trigger guard and floor plate in ExC. The bolt has only minor staining to the white finish and bright case colours. ExC original two piece woodwork

with only minor handling. ExWO&C ALR

16 - INDIAN LEE ENFIELD RIFLE

British/Indian Military SMLE bolt action rifle. 25" .303 cal barrel with correct 'square' late production nose cap with bayonet lug and correct rear sight. The wrist is marked Crown/GRI/1946/No1MKIII*. Bolt and barrel are matching numbers and metalwork has all over blue. Woodwork with all over bruising and dings. Has DT↑E (W) cartouche. GWO&C ALR

17 - NZ NO4 RIFLE

WWII Lee Enfield bolt action rifle. 25" .303 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug. The rear with ladder sight. The side rail marked No4MKI* Long Branch 1942. The wrist is N↑Z marked. The bolt, receiver and magazine are matching but stock is different. Metalwork has most overall original blue. VGC walnut woodwork. VGWO&C ALR

18 - GERMAN K98 RIFLE

Nazi German era Mauser K98 rifle. 24" 8mm cal barrel with original sights and proofs. The chamber code marked S/42 1937, correct proofs and German post war marks. Visible serial numbers are matching except the floor plate which is correct WWII type. Metalwork has thinning original blue turning grey in places. VGC original walnut stock. VGWO&C ALR

19 - SWEDISH M38 MAUSER RIFLE

WWII Swedish model 1938 short rifle. 23½" 6.5x55 cal barrel with original sights. The chamber marked Husqvarna etc. 1943. Metalwork has near all original blue with some staining to the bolt handle. ExC original woodwork complete with its swivels, rod and brass disc. VGWO&C ALR

20 - ARISAKA BAYONET

Imperial Japanese type 30 bayonet for the Arisaka rifles. 39½cm blade in the white with Nagoya arsenal mark and ¼ fuller. Guard with hooked quillon. GC grips and cleaned steel scabbard. GC

21 - '07 BAYONET

WWI SMLE 1907 bayonet. 43cm blade marked Wilkinson with 1918 date. Overall dark staining and pitting. Includes scabbard. FC

22 - MAUSER BUTCHER BAYONET

Imperial German WWI 98/05 Sawback Mauser bayonet. 36½cm blade with Mauser Oberndorf address and 1916 Ordnance mark. Old style 'high ears' on the guard and grooved wooden grips. Some pitting and staining to the blade and steel scabbard. GC

23 - MAUSER 98 BAYONET

2nd type model 1884/98 bayonet for the WWI Mauser 98. 25cm Sawback blade, the ricasso with fuller cutting through the Deutsche Maschinenfabriken logo and with imperial proof on the spine and pommel. GC grips and some staining to the guard, pommel and scabbard, complete with correct frog. GC

24 - GERMAN ERSATZ BAYONET

WWI German M88/98 Ersatz bayonet as exported to Turkey. 25cm unfullered blade with two piece hilt and flat steel grip. Scabbard is WWII coded replacement. GC

25 - GERMAN ERSATZ TURKISH BAYONET

All steel German WWI bayonet exported to Turkey. 24cm shortened blade with file sharpening marks and WWI inspectors mark. Hilt is all steel with pressed metal handle cross-guard with half muzzle ring. Scabbard is all steel. GC

26 - SWEDISH MAUSER BAYONET

All steel M1896 knife bayonet as used on the M1938 rifle. 21cm blade in the white blued knurled handle and guard with unit marking. Includes steel scabbard. Most overall original blued finish.

27 - BROWNING HI-POWER PISTOL

Vintage, circa late 60/70's Belgian M1935 semi auto pistol. 4½" 9mm cal, original matching number barrel (also on the slide and frame). Slide with original fixed sights and FN Herstal address. Metalwork has all over original Military matte blue finish. ExC original black plastic grips. Includes its 1969 dated FN marked magazine, plus spare and green Military web holster. Hard to find better. ExWO&C B/CLR

**28 - FN1910/22 PISTOL**

Seldom seen 'A' prefix FN1910/22 pistol, circa 1944. These were produced as soon as FN was liberated in late 1944 using some German occupation and new parts and signified by the A prefix. 4¼" .32ACP cal barrel with Belgian proof. Serial number on the extension is matching the frame. Slide with Herstal address etc. Metalwork has near all original blue with minor staining on the right hand side. ExC correct war time wooden grips. ExWO&C B/CLR

**29 - SOVIET MAKAROV PISTOL**

Cold War era Soviet Union Military issue semi auto pistol. 3½" 9mm Makarov cal barrel, the slide with fixed sights and only marked with serial number and cyrillic prefix, matching on the frame with Izhevsk proof and 1973 date. Metalwork has all over original bright blue. ExC original brown bakelite grips with Soviet Star. Includes its original leather holster with cleaning rod and extra 8R magazine. Hard to find better examplin in as issued. ExWO&C CLR

**30 - FINNISH BERETTA 1934 PISTOL**

WWII era Finnish Military Issue Italian manufactured pistol. 3½" .380ACP cal barrel, the slide with original sights and marked with Gardone address and 1942 date. The frame with SA acceptance mark and Italian proofs. Most original blue, thinning on the edges and where carried. GC original grips. VGWO&C CLR

**31 - ZASTAVA M70 PISTOL**

Cold War era, Yugoslavian semi auto pistol. 3¼" .32ACP cal barrel, the slide with original sight and marked Crvena Zastava etc. Metalwork has all over original blued finish. ExC original plastic grips. Appears unissued. ExWO&C CLR

**32 - FEG ATTICA PISTOL**

Hungarian Cold War era PA-63 pistol. 3¾" .32ACP cal barrel, the slide with original sights is marked with calibre and Budapest address. Alloy frame with 1971 date and metalwork has near all blued finish. ExC original bakelite grips. ExWO&C CLR

**33 - BERETTA 1934 MAGAZINES AND HOLTSE**

Red/brown leather flap holster to hold the Italian WWII pistol, plus two 7R .380 cal magazines. VGC CLR

34 - HI-POWER MAGAZINES

Two magazines for the Browning 9mm M1935 pistol, one 20R parkerised and one 15R MecGar brand, plus an unknown S.M.G magazine loader. VGC B/CLR

35 - TWO LUGER BOOKS



WWII U.S Submachine gun. 10½" fluted barrel with Cutts compensator. The receiver with basic battle sight and marked U.S MODEL OF 1928-A1 with Savage prefix (matching on the lower section) and all correct patent and inspectors marks. ExC metalwork with near all original parkerised finish. ExC original woodwork and includes its 20R magazine. ExWO&C C/P7LR

39 - M1 GARAND RIFLE

U.S Military Korean War vintage semi auto rifle, circa April 1954. 23½" .30-06 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug and correct date. The rear of the receiver is marked U.S RIFLE CAL .30 M1 H&R Arms Co. Metalwork is in ExC with near all parkerised and blue finishes. ExC woodwork with some bruising above the trigger. ExWO&C P6LR

40 - M1 CARBINE

U.S WWII semi-auto carbine. 18" .30 cal barrel with original sight and without bayonet lug. Marked underwood 4-43 with flying bomb. The chamber marked U.S CARBINE CAL .30M1. The rear has early flip up sight and marked with SAGINAW makers mark and serial number. Metalwork has thinning original finish. ExC woodwork with AAJ cartouche, sling and oiler. Includes its 15R magazine. VGWO&C P6&P7LR

41 - U.S MARK I TRENCH KNIFE

Rare and desirable U.S Military issue WWI knuckle duster Trench knife. 17cm blued double edge blade correctly unsharpened and retaining near all finish and in ExC. The brass cast handle is marked U.S 1918/L.F & C -1918 for Landers Frary & Clark and also retains nearly all its original blackened finish. Complete with its correct LF.&C. 1918 marked steel scabbard with webbing hooks in tact. Hard to find a better example. ExC

42 - GERMAN TRENCH DAGGER

WWI era German trench dagger. Variant without makers mark, straight guard and only slightly shaped grip. VGC 14.2cm blade with 2½cm false top edge and correctly unsharpened and has original leather washer. VGC wooden groove grips secured by three pins, complete with original steel scabbard with leather frog. VGC

43 - BRITISH PATTERN 1891 DIRK

Royal Naval Officers Dirk, circa 1901-1910, 45cm etched blade with Edward the 7th motif and J Gieve & Sons Portsmouth makers mark, some nickel staining in a few spots. Brass guard and Lion pommel with shagreen and wire grip. Complete with leather and brass scabbard. VG-ExC

44 - WWI NAVAL OFFICERS SWORD

Presentation British Naval Officers sword. 31½cm marked F.H Pugh from A.E.E 1917. The blade is also extensively etched with Royal Naval anchor and foliate designs. Riscasso with Wilkinson address and plug, brass one piece guard and Lions head pommel with shagreen and wire grip fitted with portope. Includes its original scabbard and original leather transit bag with owners initials. ExC

45 - PATTERN 1825 NAVAL SWORD


Antique British Naval pattern 1825 Naval Officers sword. 82cm blade with full length fuller and flat spine etched with Royal Naval and Lion insignias, brass straight stirrup hilt with black shagreen and wire grip. Some scattered pin pricking to the blade. Without scabbard. GC

46 - PATTERN 1850 CUTLASS

British Military P1850 'Lead Cutter' heavy training cutlass. 84cm straight blade. Cup hilt with wooden grip. Complete with leather scabbard. VGC

47 - PATTERN 1896 SWORD

British Artillery pattern 1896 Officers sword. 89cm straight blade with twin ¾ length fullers and flat back. Etched with George the 5th Cypher, Artillery motif and Boyton & Son makers mark. A few areas of pitting. The three bow guard has flakey plating and the shagreen has deteriorated from the grip. Worn leather scabbard cracking at the tip. FC



48 - NZ SNIDER CAVALRY CARBINE



A fine example of a NZ Military issue Snider MKIII Cavalry carbine. 19" .577 cal barrel with original sights graduated to 600 yards and British proofs. The chamber has the Snider patent arrow which is also on the latch with SNIDERS PATENT logo. Metalwork is in superb condition with overall bright reflective blue with some staining to the saddle bar without ring. The lock plate with Royal Crown is marked TOWER 1874. ExC original woodwork with steel side nails and Birmingham cartouche, the brass butt plate is marked A N↑Z and rack number. Hard to find a better example for the discerning collector. ExWO&C ALR

**49 - NZ SNIDER SHORT RIFLE**

A fine example of a NZ Military issue two band MKIII short rifle. 30½" .577 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug and ordnance marks. The chamber is stamped N80Z III and rack number matching on the tang of the stock. MKIII spring latch lock marked BSA & SOLD OUT OF SERVICE. The lock plate is marked Crown VR BSA 1879 etc. Metalwork is in superb condition with most overall original blue which is still bright in areas. ExC original woodwork with steel furniture with only very minor handling marks, complete with rod and original blanco white leather sling. This gun is in near as issued condition. Hard to find a better example for the NZ collector. ExWO&C ALR

50 - BISSELL MILITARY RIFLE

Very rare and exceptional example of an English Thomas Bissell patent rifle for converting muzzle loading rifles to .577 Snider cartridge, circa 1860's. 36" round blued barrel with original Enfield type sights and marked THOMAS BISSELL 75 TOOLEY STREET LONDON. The breech, lockplate and block are also Bissell marked. The action is an unusual composite of a snider bolt with Mont Storm locking system hinged from the left hand side and has a Bissell cam operated extractor. Metalwork has near all bright blue to the barrel and case colours to the action. ExC checkered woodwork complete with rod and swivels. ExWO&C ALR

**51 - P1858 SWORD BAYONET**

British Military sword bayonet for the pattern 1858 Enfields percussion Artillery carbine and the Snider conversions. 58cm Yataghan shaped blade in ExC with WD and ordnance marks as well as Crown/VR steel guard with muzzle ring and serial/rack number. The hilt marked RJ on the spine and secured with spring. The grips are checkered hard rubber. Complete with steel scabbard. ExC

**52 - NAVAL CUTLASS BAYONET**

British Naval pattern 1858 sword bayonet sleeved for the Martini Henry. 69cm blade with ordnance mark and makers logo and has scattered pitting which is heavy towards the tip. The muzzle ring, steel cap hilt and leather grips, complete with leather scabbard and canvas frog. VGC

53 - EAST INDIA SWORD BAYONET

Antique rare Sappers & Miners sword bayonet for the East India percussion musket, circa 1840's. 57cm spear point blade with fullers extending to the point. The spine is makers marked S.HILL and there is a P4 ordnance mark near the ricasso. Integral steel handle and guard with provision for India catch. See Watts & Whites reference #134. VGC

54 - SMITH TRAVELLING PISTOL

Antique Flintlock travelling pistol, circa early 1800's. 3" approximately .50 cal octagonal browned barrel with Birmingham proof and makers mark. Box lock action with concealed trigger and ½ cock safety is marked SMITH LONDON with stand of flags design. Metalwork has thin brown and traces of original blue. VGC one piece checkered grips. VG-ExWO&C NLR

**55 - FLINTLOCK MUFF PISTOL**

Antique, circa early 1800's, muff pistol by Radford. 1½" .50 cal/38 bore turn off barrel with early style London proofs. The action is a high grade rounded box lock with concealed trigger and ½ cock safety. Engraved with stand of flags. Metalwork has dark original patina. ExC one piece grips. ExWO&C NLR

**56 - DOUBLE PERCUSSION PISTOL**

Antique English side by side pistol, circa 1830's - 50 by Gasquoine & Dyson of Manchester. 4" .50 cal/38 bore octagonal barrels with swivel ram rod and traces of the makers address and Birmingham proofs. One of the hammers is a possible repair/replacement. Engraved box lock action extending to the tang, guard and percussion cap. Cleaned white metalwork and GC checkered one piece grip. GWO&C NLR

57 - FISHER MUFF PISTOLS

A pair of antique English percussion boxlock muff pistols by Fisher of Bristol, circa 1820's. 1¾" .44cal/54 bore turn off blued barrels with Birmingham proofs. Boxlock action with concealed triggers, dolphin hammers and basic engraving. The tangs marked Fisher Bristol. Metalwork with white and blue finishes. VGC slap sided grips. VGWO&C NLR

58 - NORINCO 97 SHOTGUN

Chinese copy of the famous Winchester 1897 pump action shotgun. 20" 12g cylinder bore barrel with bead sight. Metalwork with near all bright blue finish. ExC woodwork with rubber butt pad fitted and a few handling chips to the varnish otherwise ExWO&C ALR

59 - MOSSBERG 500 SHOTGUN

U.S pump action shotgun. 20" 12g barrel with Cylinder bore. 3" chamber, iron sight and modified 5R full length magazine. Metalwork has thinned to grey in one patch on the barrel with GC woodwork. GWO&C ALR

60 - REPRO TRAPDOOR CARBINE

U.S Harrington & Richardson 'Little Big Horn' reproduction of the Model 1873 45-70 cal carbine. 21" blued barrel. Engraved and case coloured action with near all finish. VGC ½ stock with aperture sight on the wrist. VGWO&C ALR

61 - WINCHESTER 62A RIFLE

Vintage, circa 1953, U.S pump action rifle. 23" .22LR cal round barrel with modified ¾ 10R magazine, original sights and Winchester address and model etc. Most dulling blue to the barrel and bright blue to the receiver. VGC woodwork. VGWO&C ALR

62 - GERVARM RIFLE

Vintage French semi auto open bolt and .22LR rifle. 21½" stepped barrel with original target sights and markings. Metalwork has all over parkerised finish. ExC one piece woodwork missing front swivel. VGWO&C ALR

63 - BRNO MODEL 2E RIFLE

Czech, circa 1990, bolt action rifle. 24" .22LR cal barrel threaded at the end with possible replaced foresight blade and original rear sight and marked BRNO Arms 2E and CZ logo on the receiver. Blue thinning on the front of the barrel and trigger guard. GC woodwork with swivels.

64 - S&W MODEL 29 REVOLVER

Iconic U.S double action .44 Magnum cal model 29-2 revolver. 4" barrel with original adjustable sights and all factory markings, 6 shot fluted cylinder and frame with logo & patents. ExC metalwork retaining all over original bright blue and case coloured small parts. ExC original walnut medalion grips with a few small handling marks. ExWO&C B/CLR

65 - S&W 629 REVOLVER

Seldom seen 3" snub nosed barrel variant of the double action 629-1 .44 Magnum cal 6 shot revolver. Frame and barrel with original adjustable sights and all factory markings. ExC stainless metalwork with no significant marks. ExC Pachmayr rubber grips. ExWO&C CLR

66 - COLT DOUBLE EAGLE

First Edition, circa 1989, U.S Colt D/A semi auto pistol. 5" .45ACP cal barrel with original sights and First Edition marking. Stainless metalwork is in ExC as are the original grips and Colt 8R magazine. Includes original factory First Edition hard case and paperwork. Appears unused. ExWO&C B/CLR

67 - SIG P229 PISTOL

German manufactured Swiss Sig Sauer semi auto pistol. 3 3/4" 9mm cal barrel, stainless slide with fixed sights. Black alloy frame with a few scratches to the triggerguard. Fitted with Crimson Trace brand laser grips. VGWO&C CLR

68 - SIG P220 PISTOL

Swiss Sig Sauer semi auto pistol. 4 1/4" 9mm cal barrel, slide with original fixed sights and marked P220 SIG SAUER and Swiss proof. Metalwork has near all original matte finish with minor handling scratches. ExC checkered plastic original grips. VGWO&C B/CLR

69 - COLT GOLD CUP PISTOL

Target variant of the series 80 MKIV '1911' type pistol. 5" barrel, slide with original sight and markings. Metalwork has all over fine handling scratches and nickel. Rubber pachmayr grips and replacement Military type magazine. GWO&C ALR

A vintage Interarmco Erma Werke drop in sub calibre .22LR insert for P08 Luger. Consisting of replacement toggle, insert and 10R magazine, in original box. VGWO&C B/CLR

Metalwork with overall blue with some staining. GC original woodwork complete with swivels, rare correct cleaning rod and dust cover. GWO&C ALR

76 - ARISAKA TYPE 99 SHORT RIFLE

POSTAL REQUIREMENT OF 1993 ARMS ACT

All firearms, parts and ammunition (excluding antique) require a mail order form from a Police Officer validating your license. This form is forwarded on your behalf to us from your local Arms Officer / Police station. Pistols & restricted weapons require a permit to procure before delivery

EXPORT – We can export to most countries. Firearms including antique have to be exported via air freight. We have a freight forwarder who can organise this for you. An export license will need to be obtained. We charge a \$80 fee for our time in organising the export and packaging, The freight forwarder will charge you for the NZ export license and the freight for the firearm(s). This is usually charged forward and you will pay this on receiving your goods. The export process can take around 4-8 weeks. For an estimate of the export license and freight charges please contact us. NZ G.S.T (VAT/sales tax) is only on the commission / buyers premium portion of the items, because this service occurs in New Zealand this must be charged on exports. Items that are not firearms can be sent via NZ postal service and will be charged at that rate plus packaging. Some items with historical significance to New Zealand may not be able to be exported.
