The Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) is asking consumers and businesses to reduce their electricity use as much as possible from now until Friday June 18, due to forced generation outages resulting in tight grid conditions.

Here are some tips to reduce electricity use:

- Set thermostats to 78 degrees or higher - every degree of cooling increases your energy use six to eight percent.
- Close shades and blinds to reduce the amount of heat lost through windows.
- Turn off lights and pool pumps and unplug non-essential appliances.
- Avoid using large appliances (i.e., ovens, washing machines, etc.).
- Businesses should minimize the use of electric lighting and electricity-consuming equipment as much as possible.
- Large consumers of electricity should consider shutting down or reducing non-essential production processes.
