

Mid Range Prone Tactical Match

Rule Summary

- AR-10 or AR-15 platforms only
- Calibers: 223/5.56 up to and including .308/7.62mm
- All stages for record to be magazine fed, sighters are allowed to be single load.
 - No Alibi's
- Weight: Overall weight not more than 14 pounds
- Support: Harris-type “tactical bipod” or a backpack is allowed (no large F-Class bipods). Tactical adjustable stocks fitted with rear monopods are permitted but the rear monopod may not be used for support during record shots.
- Optics: Scope not more than 12X
- Barrel: Not more than 20"
- Muzzle brakes and suppressors are allowed, muzzle brake baffles will be provided
- Trigger: Trigger pull not less than 4.5 pounds
- Tactical/issue slings allowed – competition slings, shooting coats and gloves are not allowed.
- The match is tactical by design and the only gear allowed to be brought up to the firing line are a cased rifle, backpack/shooting bag and shooting mat.

Long Range Prone Tactical Match

Rule Summary

- Any semi-automatic gas operated or bolt action rifle constructed with an external magazine capable of an 10-, 20-, or 30- round box magazine,
- All stages for record to be magazine fed, sighters are allowed to be single load.
 - No Alibi's
- Weight: Overall weight not more than 16 pounds
- Support: Harris-type “tactical bipod” or a backpack is allowed (no large F-Class bipods). Tactical adjustable stocks fitted with rear monopods are permitted but the rear monopod may not be used for support during record shots.
- Optics: Scope not more than 25X
- Muzzle brakes and suppressors are allowed, muzzle brake baffles will be provided
- Trigger: Trigger pull not less than 1.5 pounds
- Tactical/issue slings allowed – competition slings, shooting coats and gloves are not allowed.
- The match is tactical by design and the only gear allowed to be brought up to the firing line are a cased rifle, backpack/shooting bag and shooting mat.
